

A RESOLUTION BY THE HURRICANE CITY COUNCIL
ESTABLISHING A NEW POWER RATE SCHEDULE
FOR HURRICANE CITY POWER

WHEREAS Hurricane City desires to protect the health, safety, and welfare of its citizens;

WHEREAS Hurricane City's ordinances require power rates to be adopted by resolution;

WHEREAS Hurricane City desires to ensure that these fees are fair and equitable to all citizens;

WHEREAS Hurricane City's costs to purchase and produce power for its customers has increased substantially;

WHEREAS the City Council desires to ensure the finances and accounts of the City's Power Department remain stable during this period of increased costs for whole power; and

WHEREAS the City Council desires to ensure power rates are revenue neutral, and the Power Board has recommended an increase in rates to accomplish revenue neutrality.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF HURRICANE, UTAH that kwh rates charged to City of Hurricane Power customers shall increase by fifteen percent (15%) across all power rate classes. In addition, the base charge shall increase by one dollar (\$1.00) for all rate classes except for large commercial, which shall increase by twenty dollars (\$20.00). These updated power rates and base charges for all Hurricane City Power service areas are set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto. The updated rates and charges set forth in this Resolution shall be effective for electricity usage occurring in October 2022, which will be billed in November 2022.
