



Rules and Regulations of Cemetery Grounds:

- 1. Recreational activities are not permitted
- 2. Animals are not allowed on Cemetery property.
- 3. No soliciting, sales or pan-handling.
- 4. No signs or advertisements
- 5. Motor vehicles shall travel only on designated roadways without previous consent of Cemetery Personnel.
- 6. Temporary memorials may be removed without notice when they become unsightly or pose a safety hazard or when necessary for regular maintenance or are not Compliant with City Ordinance.
- 7. Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by a parent or supervising adult.
- 8. The grass in the Cemetery may not be disturbed without prior approval of Cemetery Personnel.
- 9. It is unlawful to be present in the Cemetery during night time hours.

Cemetery Policies



Maintenance: Cemetery staff provides regular cleaning, turf care, raising and leveling of monuments and markers. Health and safety considerations will prevail in the determination of priorities.

Flowers properly displayed add to the beauty of the Cemetery. The cemetery crew will not be responsible for flowers or personal property left in the Cemetery. No glass containers are permitted in the Cemetery. Flowers on new graves will be removed after 5 days.

Memorial Day: Cemetery crew begin preparation for Memorial Day the Monday prior to the holiday. Decorations may be placed on Friday afternoon through the end of Memorial Day. Cleanup will be the Monday following the holiday, decorations that have not been picked up will be disposed of at the county landfill.

Burial Permits and Payment:

No Interment will be at the City Cemetery unless a burial permit from a licensed mortuary is submitted to Cemetery Staff. Remains from out-of-state shall be accompanied by a Transit Permit. Payment of City burial fees shall be made to the licensed mortuary submitting the required permits, unless the burial charges have been paid in advance to the Hurricane City Treasurer.

Interment Hours: No interment or graveside service will be held in the Cemetery on Sunday or on any of the holidays officially observed by the City of Hurricane. Interments and graveside services will be allowed between the hours of 10:00 am and 4:00 pm. All interments and graveside services must be arranged forty-eight hours (48) hours in advance. On intervening holidays or Sundays, arrangements must be made seventy-two (72) hours in advance. Any exception must be approved by the Superintendent and will result in additional fees.



Monument/Grave Markers: Monument and grave markers will be installed by private firms. The Cemetery office must receive a minimum of forty-eight (48) hours' notice before installation. Installers are responsible for the removal of all excess debris and must restore the lot to its original condition. Patrons are responsible for removal and re-installment of any marker or monument deemed oversized by the cemetery staff. (See additional information sheet for size of monuments)

Upright monuments are allowed but may not be more than 42" high.

Cremation / Infant monuments are required to be flat.

Memorial Placement: All temporary memorials must be placed on a raised portion of the monument or in a permanent receptacle in the concrete border of the monument. A single shepherd hook may be placed adjacent to the concrete border. One shepherd hook per monument permitted. Receptacles must be of a type approved by Cemetery Staff.

It is unlawful for any person to plant any vegetation upon any lot or lots in the Cemetery.
