



Peach Days 2023 Entry Information



DISPLAYS:

- To be judged, entries must be *completed in the last year, and never entered* in Peach Days competitions before.
- "Display Only" entries are also accepted.
- All entries will be judged (unless display only) and receive ribbons
- **ALL RIBBONS HAVE CASH PRIZES: Sweepstakes-\$15, Reserve Sweeps-\$10, Blue - \$5, Red - \$3 and White - \$1.**
- **Collect prize money at premium bank** (Fri. & Sat 2-5 pm Rm 126)
- Enter display items 4 to 8:30 pm Wed. Aug. 30.
- Entries picked up Sat. Sept. 2 from 9 to 10 pm.
- **NO EARLY WITHDRAWAL. NO EXCEPTIONS!**

Home Arts (Enter Wed Aug. 30 from 4-8:30 pm)

- Enter crafts such as tole, woodworking, sewing and handicrafts, quilts, dolls, dried flower arrangements, etc.
- Youth and Adult divisions. Enter as often as you like.
- All ribbons will receive cash.
- Special large displays by invitation (or call if interested).

Fine Arts (Enter Wed. Aug. 30 from 4-8:30 pm)

- Enter in 6 categories: 1) Pencil/chalk/charcoal/pen/ink. 2) 3-D. 3) Watercolor. 4) Oils, acrylics. 5) Mixed media. 6) Photography.
- Entries limited to 2 items total per person.
- Artwork/ photography **MUST be ready to hang w/ a wire on back.**
- Divisions: Professional; Semi-prof; Amateur; Youth (high school age 16-18); Youth (middle school age 13-15); Children (elementary age 7 -12); Children (age 6 and under) and Special Needs.
- Size limit (because of display space) no larger than 2'x4'.
- All ribbons will receive cash.

Garden, Flowers, Baked/Bottled & Small Farm (Enter Wed Aug. 30 from 4-8:30 pm)

1. There will be a youth division age 16 and under in baking only.
2. All other categories are general entry.
3. All ribbons will receive cash.

Garden/egg judging guidelines:

- Enter 3 items (5 for small size) of comparable size, shape & color per entry on a white paper plate except large items (melons etc.)
- Farm Fresh Eggs: Enter one dozen of like sized eggs.
- Entries should be clean and ready for judging.

Small Farm Display: a larger display of "farmed" items (fruits, vegetables, eggs, flowers, bottled, etc.) creatively displayed. May use farm "props." Reserve a spot by Mon. Aug. 28

Flowers

- Fresh cut flowers - enter individual or a multi flower bouquet.
- Judged on size, quality, color/variety, design and composition.

Bottled goods judging guidelines

- Display preserved food in a clean, clear standard canning jar.
- Leave proper headspace for each variety. (1" for low acid foods, vegetables and meat; 1/2" for acid foods, fruits & tomatoes; 1/4" for jams and jellies.)
- Product should not be mushy or over-processed.

Baked goods and candy judging guidelines

- Must include a recipe card with ingredients listed.
- All ribbons will receive cash.
- There must be at least 5 samples/entry except for bread/ pies.
- No entries that require refrigeration.
- Enter items on a paper plate in a Ziploc bag or wrapped in plastic.
